



## Reception, Year 1 and Year 2

Dear parents/ guardians,

To celebrate St.David's Day – Dydd Gwyl Dewi Sant and to show how proud we are to be Welsh, Ysgol y Foryd and Ysgol Maes Owen will be parading from school to Tir Prince and once there, we will have a celebration. We are inviting you to come and celebrate with us at Tir Prince Raceway from 10am where both schools will be performing Welsh songs and traditional Welsh folk dances, with some special guests too.

The children will come to school on the 4<sup>th</sup> March, wearing their traditional Welsh costumes, Welsh football or rugby tops, or red, white or green clothes. You can then make your way to Tir Prince, where you will be able to park, bring your own chairs to sit on and there will be hot and cold drinks for you to buy from the Market Central Café. We will then start parading from school and we aim to start the celebrations at 10am.

Once we have finished, the children will parade back to school to continue with their celebrations.

The children will still get to celebrate in school but the parade won't go ahead if it's not safe to do so – but we are not going to think about rain!!!!)
